- Don't respond to your dog if it barks or whines and make sure it understands that it can't sit on any valuable furniture.
- If your dog gets fidgety don't pay it any mind as you enter or leave a room. And only respond to it after it has calmed down.

Grooming Tips

As you train your Chihuahua, you have to make sure you groom it well enough that it enjoys the process. So that the next time you take out your **dog nail clippers**, it sits calmly and waits for you to finish. As such, down below are some grooming tips to help you do just that.

- If your dog has long hair, brush it at least 3 times a week. Making sure that you cover key areas like its lower chest, legs, and tail.
- When it comes to bathing, the kitchen sink should do just fine. But as you shampoo your dog, make sure none of it gets into its eyes.
- Make sure that you use a dog shampoo and not your own.
- Clean its ears regularly by taking a cotton ball dipped in some baby oil. Gently wipe the inside of its ears by starting at the deeper end first.
