The Cause and Effect Essay

There are two ways of writing a cause and effect essay, the block or chain method. In the block method you first discuss all causes for an event before moving on to its effects. On the other hand, in a chain structure you highlight one cause after another with each link leading up to what it caused until finally getting back to where we started at why this happened by examining its ultimate outcome as well as possible outcomes if there were no intervention along that final causal line.

The Problem and Solution Essay

This essay should be short and persuasive. It starts by analyzing the issue, before proposing a solution that will solve it. Keep in mind your goal is to convince readers why your proposed solution is better than the existing one for them. Or you may go for an [essay writer online](#)

The Comparison and Contrast Essay

Comparative essays compare two subjects that belong to the same category. For example, you can write a comparative essay on two football players and not between one footballer and an artist. If you can't understand this example you can go for a [free essay writer](#).
